DIAGNOSIS: Abnormal mammogram on the left. My ultrasound here in the office suggests this area is most likely a breast cyst [610.0].

ALLERGIES: The patient is allergic to Codeine, Benadryl, Reglan, Pravachol, Vioxx, Darvocet and Arthrotec 75. Tolerates Vicodin.

SURGERY/PROCEDURE: Proceed with compression view as previously ordered and proceed with needle drainage under ultrasound guidance.

- 3. Urinalysis
- 4. Prothrombin Time
- 5. Partial Thromboplastin Time
- 6. Electrolytes (Cl-, K+, Na+, CO2--)
- 7. Hepatic (Bili, Tot/Direct, ALP, AST, ALT, ALB) (** Fast 12 hours prior to test **)
- 8. Basic Panel (Lytes plus Glu, BUN, Creat) (** Fast 12 hours prior to test **)
- 9. Lipid Panel (Trig, Chol, HDL, LDL) (** Fast 12 hours prior to test **)
- 10. Metabolic Panel (Basic plus ALB, Ca++, Bili, ALP, AST, Protein) (** Fast 12 hours prior to test **)
- 11. Type and Screen
- 12. Type and Crossmatch Units Packed RBC Units Whole Blood
- 13. IV D5LR at 125 cc/hr
- 14. DIET: Nothing to eat or drink after 23:00
- 15. EKG
- 16. Chest X-ray
- 17. Anti-Emboic Stockings
- 18. Incentive Spirometer - Goal > 2000 cc 10 x /hr.
- 19. Insert Foley Catheter
- 20. PCA Teaching
- 21. Eggcrate Mattress
- 22. _____
